- managing accidents, incidents, and internal nonconformities by implementing effective and sustainable corrective and preventive actions,
- identifying foreseeable emergencies and preparing the organization and resources through organizational plans,
- empowering employees by maintaining and developing their skills through training and awareness-raising, as well as involving subcontractors.
- measuring, monitoring, and continuously improving our performance and management system to prevent major accidents, ensure optimal health and safety conditions for all employees and subcontractors, and to ensure that we preserve the security of our sites and the integrity of our goods.
